AFTER SCHOOL OFFERINGS

Enrichment and Extended Day activities are one hour long, unless otherwise noted. To enroll your child, please complete and return the attached sign-up sheet along with your payment. ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES

Study Hour

Study Hour is available Monday through Thursday. The time will be monitored by our instructors, and students will have the opportunity to finish homework. Although Study Hour is not a tutoring session, it is an academic period with instructors available for assistance. Students who finish homework early will be directed to read until the end of Study Hour.

Etiquette (Grades 6-8)

An instructor from *The Cotillion Group* will enlighten students on appropriate manners and social skills for use in everyday and formal situations. Topics covered will include meeting people, making introductions, telephone etiquette (especially cell phones), buffet protocol, and attending special social functions. (Minimum 5)

Monkey Joe's (Grades K-6)

Students can improve their physical fitness while having a blast and playing on inflatable jumps, slides, and climbing walls! An Eaton staff member will walk students to Monkey Joe's and will supervise play at the facility. Pick-up will be at Monkey Joe's at 2:45 pm. Participants must be 12 years old or under. (Minimum 3)

Bowling

Each week students will participate in two games of recreational bowling at Brunswick Zone with their peers. Participants will be walked to the facility by Eaton staff who will remain on-site to facilitate appropriate behavior and safety. Students may bring money for the Snack Bar. Parents need to pick up children from the bowling lanes at 3:00 pm.

Keyboarding

An instructor from Successful Technology Skills will instruct students in correct typing techniques, focusing on the development of good habits to increase typing speed and accuracy. A special keyboard is used to provide immediate feedback to the students regarding performance. Pacing is individualized. (Minimum 3)

Music

An instructor from *Music in Your School* will lead students on an exploration of various musical genres. Students will listen to samplings of compositions and songs from a wide range of styles and languages. The journey will include singing, rhythm exercises, and demonstrative movement. Specific activities will depend on the make-up of the class. (Minimum 5)

Chess Club

A coach from *Championship Chess* will help students build their individual chess skills through instruction, games, and guided analysis. Strategic planning is discussed and practiced. Students of all ability levels are encouraged to join. (Minimum 5)

Art

Students will develop their individual artistic talents and styles under the professional supervision of an instructor from *Out of the Box Art Studio*. They will create their own projects from a mixed media palette, which will include clay, painting, and collage (specific media used will depend on class make-up). When appropriate, the instructor will provide contextual background for the type of artwork. A supply fee of \$30 is included. (Minimum 5)

EXTENDED DAY ACTIVITIES

Lego Robotics

An instructor from *Club Scientific* will teach students to build and program robots to perform a variety of functions. Students will work with Lego Education Robotics kits in class. The instructor will load appropriate software onto the students' own laptops to expand the experience beyond the classroom. (Minimum 8)

Karate

A Joe Corley Karate instructor will guide students in developing discipline, fitness, confidence, honor, focus, and respect. Students will need to have a uniform (may be purchased independently or from the instructor). These sessions are appropriate for all levels, even the beginner. Karate will take place in the multi-purpose room of the Brunswick Zone. Pick-up will be at the Zone at 4:00 pm. Price includes the cost of graduation. (Minimum 6)

Swimming

SwimAtlanta will offer lessons in a small class setting just around the corner from Eaton Academy. An Eaton staff member will walk swimmers to SwimAtlanta for each 30-minute class (the staff member will not stay with the group). Pick-up will be at 3:30 pm at SwimAtlanta. Price includes a \$20 SwimAtlanta registration fee. (Minimum 6)

Piano

Music in Your School offers 30-minute private piano lessons here at school for students of all levels. The instructor will supply a keyboard for the session. Specific lesson contents will vary with the ability of the student. Time slots will be allotted on a first come, first served basis.

Sports Club

Sports Club will focus on basketball and training for the Peachtree Jr. 3K run in May. Students will start by learning the rules and skills of basketball through practice, drills, and games. Later, they'll shift to building endurance and learning about pacing in preparation for the Peachtree Jr. Ms. Armstrong will lead the group at the Wills Park gymnasium. This club is open to all ages and skill levels. Parent drivers are needed. (Minimum 5)
